Collaborations

San Rocco is a magazine produced by a disparate group of young architects, designers, and photographers. Named after a historic collaboration between Aldo Rossi and Giorgio Grassi, *San Rocco* is born from a desire to discuss and excavate historical and contemporary critical thinking in architecture. Their installation consists of a gigantic table in the Arsenale on which is placed a collection of objects—architectural models of inspirational projects. Some of these models have been newly created but are based on historic projects; others have been created by contemporary practices or individuals. Each has, in some way, had an impact on the work of *San Rocco*, either through inspiring the group's work, or through direct collaboration. Together they suggest the complex, collaborative, and networked nature of architectural production.

San Rocco sees architecture as a form of collective knowledge that is produced through the efforts of a multitude. The table presented at the 13th International Architecture Exhibition also expresses the ambiguity between *San Rocco* as a collective architecture practice and *San Rocco* as a journal. The magazine begins with a "call for papers." This open invitation frames a potential discussion on architecture, and functions as a conceptual work of architecture itself. Blurring inspiration and production, originality and recreation, collaboration and authorship, and construction and criticism, the diversity of approaching the practice of architecture is given expression through the large, varied collection of the objects on display.

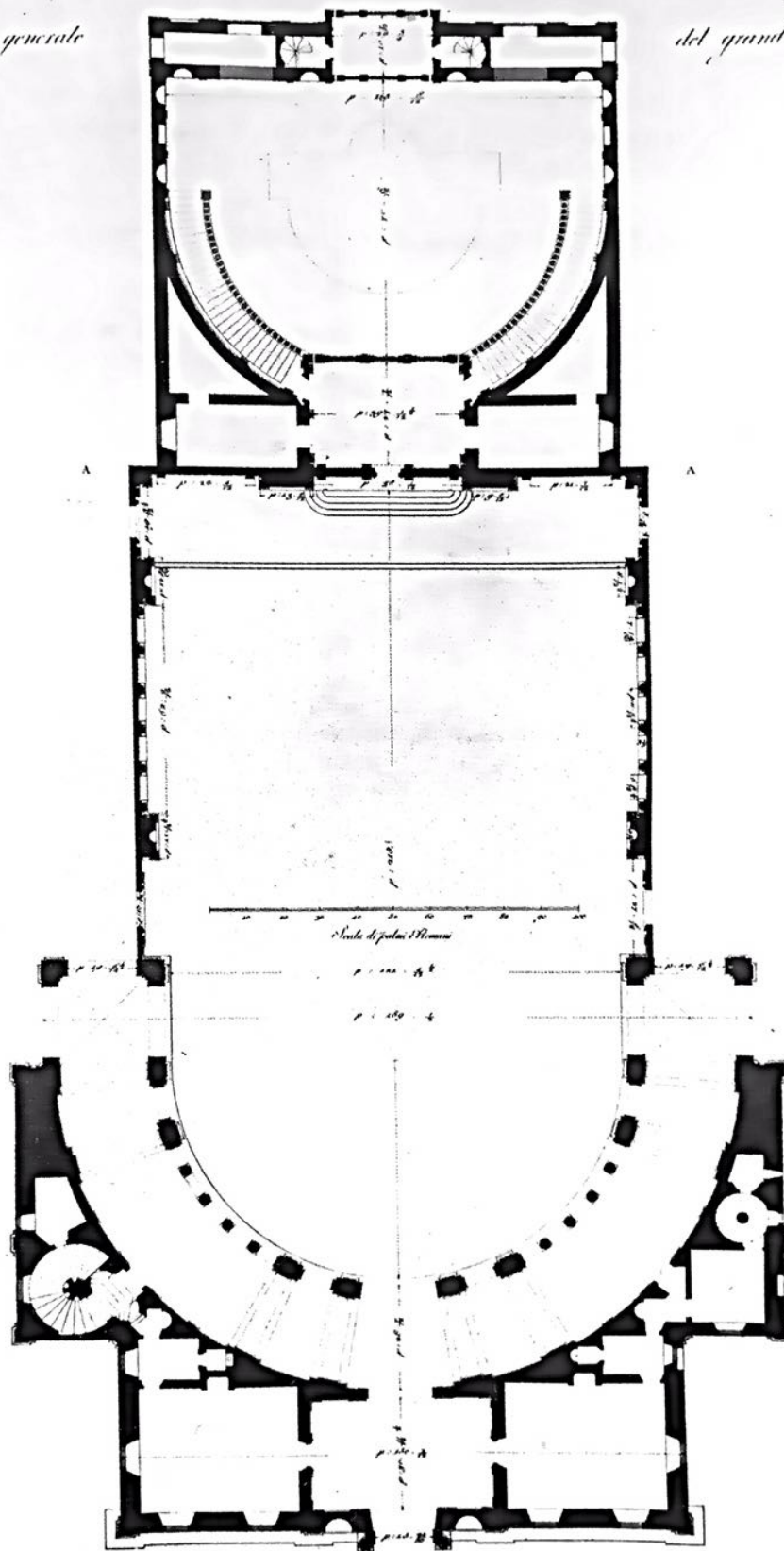
