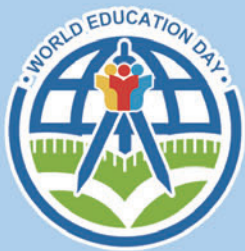

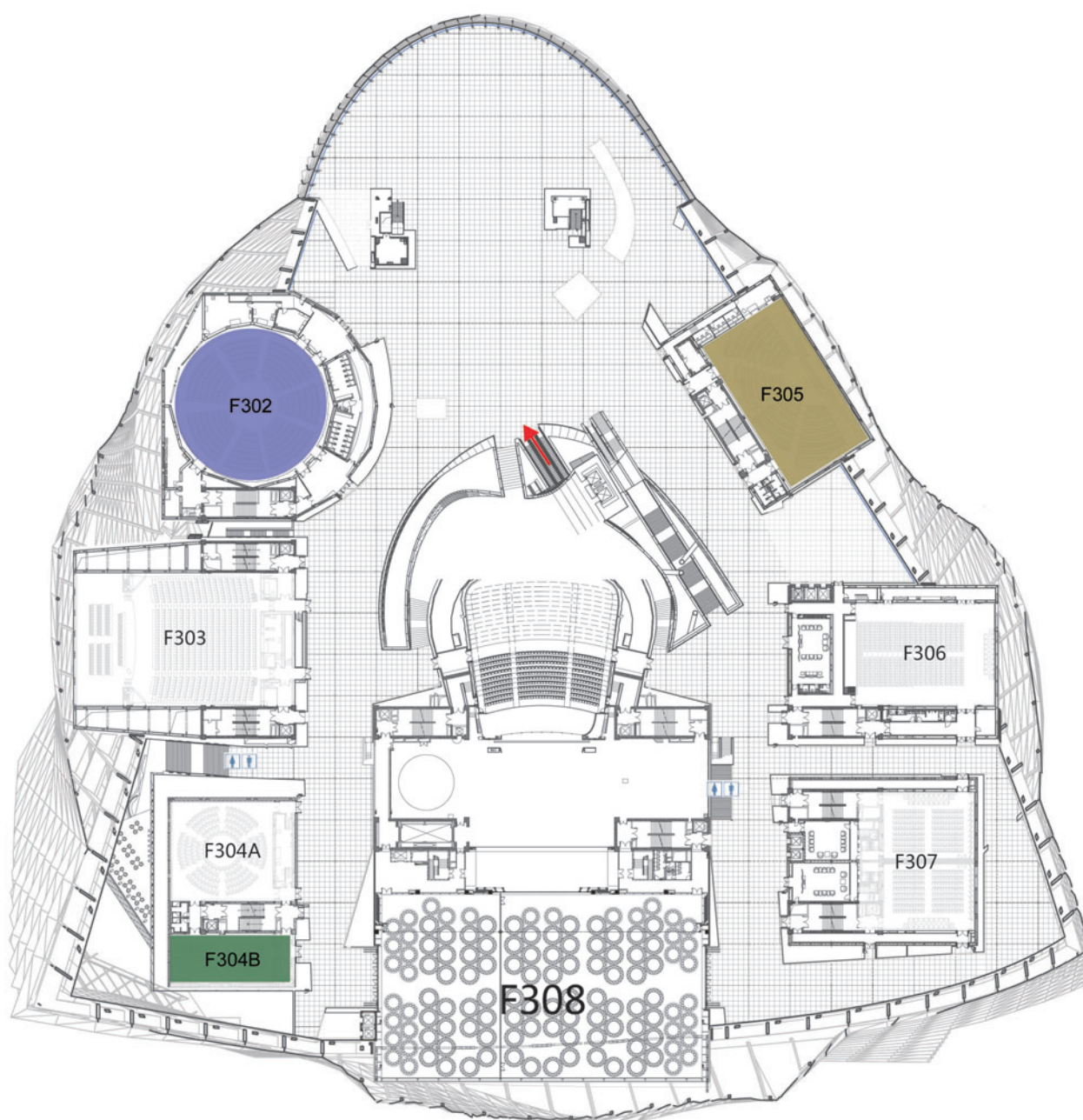

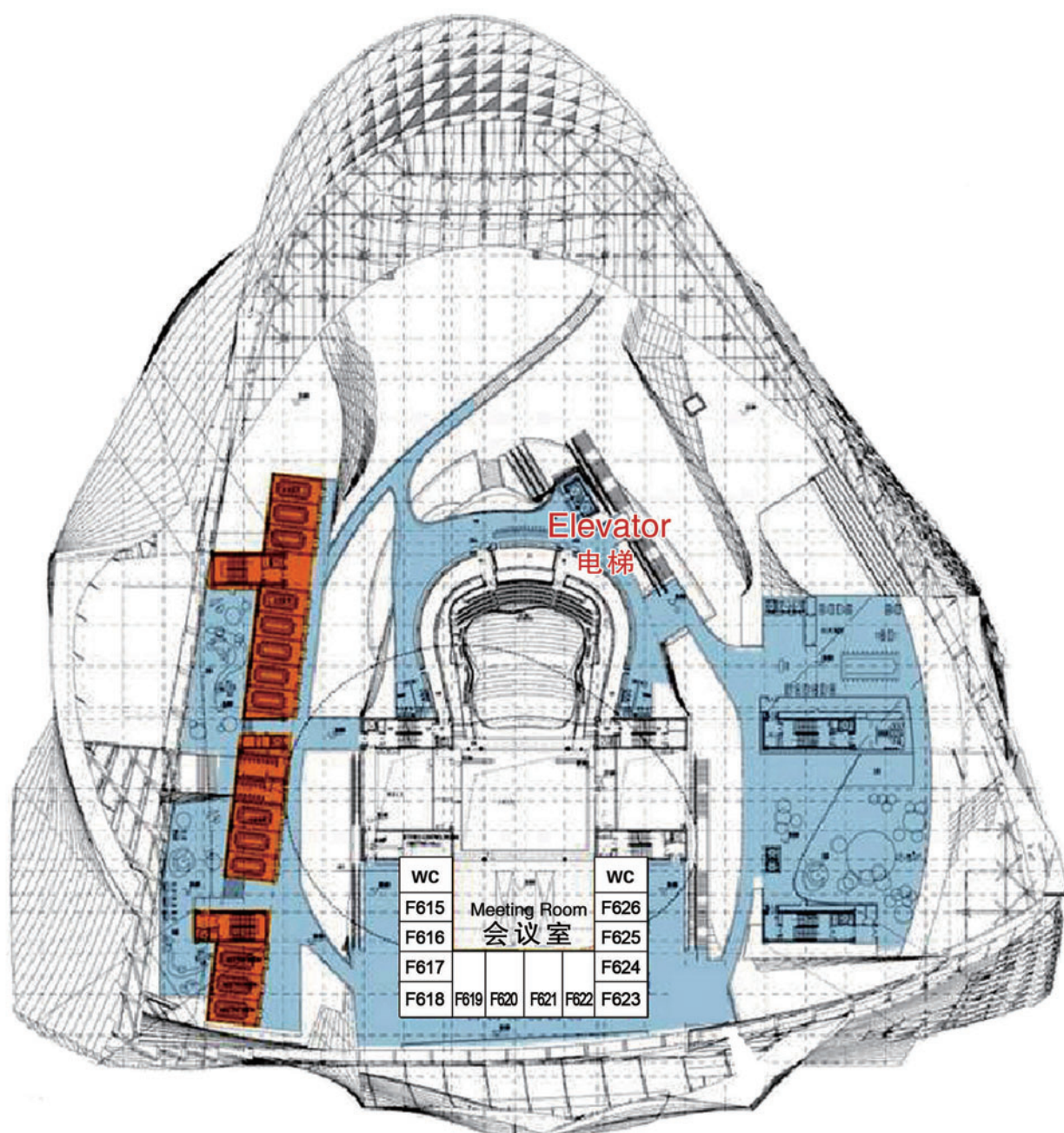
The Third Floor Plan of Dalian International Conference Center

Abstract

The teaching and research experience carried out within the Design Department laboratories of the Politecnico di Milano brings young students closer to understanding the design potentials of wood. New trends and languages are being born and increase the value of the sensorial qualities of this great material. This work "around and inside wood" is to highlight the uniqueness and the opportunity of tactile, real and material experimentation of the world, in particular among the youngest that are an increasingly digital, virtual and immaterial generation.

Dr. Mariano Chernicoff works in the Exhibit Design workshop of the Design Department and is a lecturer for the Modelling Design and Wood Design courses at the Politecnico di Milano_School of Design. Works as designer for exhibitions and events designer, is technical consultant at the Master in Furniture Design. Born in Argentina, since 2000 lives in Italy. Degree in Industrial Design and Master's Degree in Interior Design at the Politecnico di Milano. In 2003 began working for the Design Department, gaining much experience in the field of exhibitions, events and modelling/prototyping with different materials. His passion for the Wood knowledge has emerged in different activities: teaching field, exhibitions and international scientific publications. He has been member of the jury in wood competitions and explores new approaches for the teaching based on direct and concrete experience with materials. Since 2011 leads the Politecnico di Milano's Exhibit Design Laboratory that designs, builds and carry out the most important events of the University.

Silvia Piardi Born in Milan, graduated in Architecture at the Politecnico di Milano with top marks in 1975, the same year she enables the profession of architect. Member of the Order of Journalist, since 2003 is full professor in Industrial Design at the Politecnico di Milano, Department of Design. She co-founded and directed until 2003 the Degree in Interior Design.
